School year registration will begin **July 16** for returning students. You will receive a placement postcard and details on how to make a registration appointment in mid-July.

Important Information and Changes:

We follow current Covid guidelines for Illinois, and continue to keep students separated in class, however students will move around the classroom more and will no longer be restricted to dance "squares" for the full class.

Zoom: If you need to quarantine during a week of classes, will be on vacation, are unable to get to the studio physically, or just want to take remotely, you can sign up and just take on Zoom! **Please contact the office in advance if you want a Zoom link for your class. We will not be automatically starting on Zoom anymore unless we know someone will be on!** "Camps" are not available in this format, but all dance,

CGPAC Summer Class FAQ:

Do we need to wear masks? Yes, at all times if you are unvaccinated. Vaccinated students can present their vaccination card to have a mask release indicated on their account.

How do we register? We have printed brochures at the studio, you can print it at home and return via email (or drop off/mail).

What is the online waiver? And does everyone need to submit it? All families will be required to digitally sign off on our new CGPAC student waiver. It covers safety precautions of taking virtual classes online, personal injury risk both in-person and online, a photo/video release, and risks of taking in-person class due to COVID-19. All families from 2020-2021 have signed it, new families please complete it.

What are the cleaning procedures? Barres will be sanitized. Staff will continually wipe down common touch surfaces. Pro-Clean D will be used to clean the floors multiple times a week in addition to wet Swiffer cleaner used multiple times daily. A UV-C 100W disinfecting light will sterilize every classroom and bathroom multiple times a week. We also have air purifying iWave-C units installed on our 3 HVAC units, dehumidifiers in each classroom, and fans blowing in fresh air from open doors and windows in classrooms with outside access.

What other precautions are you taking? While we are no longer taking student temperatures upon entry, we expect that you will only send students who are in good health with no Covid-19 symptoms. We recommend that all students will bring: an individual hand sanitizer (attached to your dance bag) to have access to during class (2oz CGPAC keychain sanitizer bottles are available), a yoga mat if taking modern, hip hop, or jazz (for floor work), a "barre coozi" to wrap around the barre to keep your hand from touching the actual surface (instructional video on website) although these are now optional. Please leave street shoes in the lobby in a designated space. The lobby will remain closed. Parents will stay outside unless needing to register/pay. Everyone will wear a mask. We have a marked enter and exit door for one way traffic. Dressing rooms with social distancing markings will be open to masked dancers age 11+ who are staying for multiple classes and have a 15-30 minute break (please discuss with your student if they will need to use this option). Students can bring a water bottle or buy one from the desk for \$1, there is no drinking fountain ac-

We offer a variety of dance, music, and theatre workshops, classes and camps. Summer is a great time to try something new, or get back into something you used to do! With five single weeks of classes, we can accommodate even the busiest schedules. Don't see a time that works? Private voice, piano, and dance lessons also available both in person and on Zoom. Please email for availability.

Registration: Please use the enclosed form. Mail, scan/email, or drop off at CGPAC starting immediately!

Cancellations/Refunds: Since we have minimum enrollment requirements, we recommend that you register at least 2 weeks prior to the start date of any class. Classes with insufficient registration will be cancelled one week prior to each start date (full refund given). Classes dropped with in one week of the start date will be given account credit for future use, and no refunds/credits will be given once a class has started.

Placement: Please sign up for the **same level you took this past year** for summer classes, regardless of where you anticipate being placed for fall. For placement help, please email Miss Amy at cgpac1@gmail.com.

Reminder that all classes are scheduled to be in person. If needed, we may switch to Zoom at any time. We hope this does not have to happen, but are ready if needed.
