

CGPAC Dancer Scholarship Application 2022

Several scholarships have been established for which qualified dancers may apply. If you wish to submit an application, please read the following requirements, fill out the form, attach your essay(s), and return it in to CGPAC no later than 1:00 pm, Saturday, May 21st, 2022 (via email or if printed, through the drop slot in the dancewear store door).

Several different judges will be assembled to review the applications and vote for the recipients. The winners will be announced at the last recital on Sunday, June 5th (Blue Cast) and ALL applicants will receive a portion of the fund. Since we do not know until that night what the total fund will be, we can't say how much each student will receive, but all of the funds will be distributed back to the students.

Who may apply? Dancers in good financial standing in grades 6-12 who study at least three different dance forms (ballet, tap, jazz, modern, pointe, hip hop, swing choir), one of which must be ballet.

What are the scholarships?

1. \$200.00 Liz Dolak Memorial Scholarship – essay contest – Write an essay (one page) on the topic **“A lesson I’ve learned taking dance that has nothing to do with dance”**
2. \$200.00 Teachers’ Scholarship (grades 6-8) – voted on by the teachers (talent, effort, attendance, and attitude will all be considered in this category)
3. \$200.00 Teachers’ Scholarship (grades 9-12) – voted on by the teachers (talent, effort, attendance, and attitude will all be considered in this category)
4. \$200.00 “Model Student” Award and Scholarship – All class assistants will be eligible for this award. The supervising teachers will be asked to review their assistants. From this, a model student will be chosen.

The monetary amounts noted for each scholarship can be used toward either classes at CGPAC or dance convention (summer or winter). The family accounts of the winners will be credited the amount of the award. Those students awarded scholarships from CNADM or DMW are eligible to apply for scholarships from CGPAC, however students may win only one award from CGPAC per year.

Past winners are welcome to apply again, but not for the same award earned the previous year.
